

Setting target times for each hole is the best way to set golfer expectations while managing and improving pace of play. The Visage Display Unit (VDU) tracks pace against the target times and communicates status back to the Visage Control Center (VCC), and if enabled will also display minutes behind on the golfer's VDU.

A best practice is to use the information found in the average time per hole report to adjust target times by hole. This provides a realistic target and better flow to the round, improved experience with faster play, or potentially allows you to increase rates due to the lower pace of play and overall value in a round at your facility.

## Average time per hole

The Average Time per Hole Report is accessed via the Visage Control Center (VCC) Pace view Reports tab. The report can be viewed by a specified date range, Month to Date, Quarter to Date, or Year to Date.
